### Literacy

April was a very busy month in Class 3! The students began learning about what it means to "Go Green". They used recycled and reused items such as paper towel rolls to make rainsticks and binoculars, an empty juice jug to make a class watering can, empty playdoh cups to make planters for our herb garden and many more! Our TELL literacy book for this month was, "Come Out and Play Little Mouse". The students worked on finding core vocabulary from our story, such as "play", "me", "not" and "go" and identifying them with their core boards/Go Talks.

### Numeracy

As an extension of our "Going Green" unit, the students used recycled materials to sort (metal, plastic, glass and paper), which reinforced the concept "same" and "different". They also sorted objects by recycling or garbage and compared which grouping had "more" or "less". Class 3 participated in many sensory activities as an extension of our Birds unit. They enjoyed sorting feathers of various colours on the light tray and searched through bird seed to find numbers. A class favourite this month was following recipes to make Earth Day cupcakes and Rice Krispie bird nests.

### Science

Class 3 learned about various birds that are found in our community, such as Robins, Blue Jays, Cardinals, Geese and Chickens. They worked on identifying the birds based on the sound that they make and learned interesting facts about each. We made our very own "chicken coop" using recycled cardboard boxes and other materials. This was an exciting opportunity to participate in imaginative play!
