- Research and identify alternate technology-based opportunities to support learning in Special Education classrooms as well as in student transition to community schools.
- Attend professional development in the area of reading and Brain Computer Interface and share information with staff.
- Facilitate the current work happening in the area of Brain Computer Interface being conducted at the School Authority.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the principal.

## 21st CENTURY TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS:

- Ontario Teaching Certificate and member in good standing with the Ontario College of Teachers.
- Special Education Qualifications (minimum Part 1, Specialist preferred)
- Extensive knowledge of and experience with adaptive technology and software and the integration of information and computer technology in instruction for students with exceptionalities in both panels.
- Strong working knowledge of diagnostic approaches, assessment, differentiated instruction and assistive technology in Special Education.
- Minimum 2 years of experience in community schools working with students with a diverse range of exceptionalities as well as communication challenges.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills (written and oral).
- Demonstrated ability to work within a multidisciplinary team and community partners.
- Experience working within a continuum of special education service delivery models.
- Experience providing community educator workshops and in-services on a wide range of topics related to special education.
