The salary is commensurate with a position of added responsibility (inclusive of Teacher in Charge Responsibilities).

DUTIES:

- Provide educational consultation and support to the JMCC, JMCCSA, and local district school boards and community partners;
- Collaborate as a member of a multidisciplinary team supporting students with physical and/or neurological disabilities currently attending JMCC School or local district schools;
- Consult with JMCCSA staff regarding assessment interpretation, report writing, strategies to support classroom teachers, curriculum modifications, accommodations, and alternative curriculum;
- Provide on-going support and programming /teaching strategies for students related to their assistive technology and 21st Century core competencies;
- Provide staff development, organization, and delivery in all areas of Special Education, including universal design, differentiated instruction, assistive technology;
- Support analysis of data related to special education programming and services in alignment with the JMCCSA Strategic Plan;
- Provide leadership within JMCCSA (Teacher in Charge, IEP, SEA, NTIP) and collaborate to support Ministry of Education and JMCCSA initiatives;
- Perform other duties as assigned by the principal.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Ontario Teaching Certificate and member in good standing with the Ontario College of Teachers;
- Specialist in Special Education or Special Education Qualifications accompanied by additional ESL qualifications;
- Extensive knowledge of and experience with adaptive technology and software and the integration of information and computer technology in instruction for students with exceptionalities in both panels;
- Strong working knowledge of diagnostic approaches, assessment, differentiated instruction and assistive technology in Special Education;
- Minimum 5 years of experience in community schools working with students with a diverse range of exceptionalities as well as communication challenges;
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills (written and oral);
- Extensive knowledge and experience with the current special educational programs and services of local district school boards;
