WHAT WE ARE LEARNING...

We have been very busy in Class 3 exploring our outdoor environment and using nature to help us learn. Thank you to all the families and carers for sending in weather appropriate clothing so we can have these meaningful opportunities.

During our Literacy focus, we will be exploring a variety of texts that relate to various body parts. This will allow the students to gain a richer understanding of core focus words: good, have, here, like, my/mine. These texts are related to our TELL Program and the story "Here Are My Hands". Students have been engaged in a variety of hands on learning experiences from viewing x-rays of hands, feet, etc. to bath time with different dolls. We will continue to learn about different letters of the alphabet and expose students to sensory learning activities.

During small group Math activities, students will explore different types of patterns. We will expose students to AB patterns and use different type of materials as well our school environment for hands on learning activities.

We have been very busy in Class 3 learning about ice and snow during our inquiry groups. Students have participated in a variety of hands on learning activities to create ice catchers, crystal snowflakes and using their sense of touch to create their own snowman. We will continue to focus on winter themes through identifying winter animals.
