Classroom Glimpse

Every day, students in Class 5 participate in a sensory circle. This activity is a class favourite and engages 4 of the 5 senses - hearing, smelling, sight, and touch. In addition to being an engaging sensory experience, it also provides an opportunity for students to practice communication, as they express a desire for a turn, 'more'/'not' or share a 'like'/'not' reaction.
