### **The Board of Trustees – John McGivney School Authority (JMSA)**

The John McGivney School Authority (JMSA) is one of six school authorities located in hospitals or Children's Treatment Centres in Ontario and mandated under Section 68 of the *Education Act*. The JMSA is independent of local district school boards, and as such, has its own trustees. The JMSA strives to promote diversity and equality of opportunity.

### **Qualifications**

The John McGivney School Authority Board is composed of 5 to 7 trustees, appointed by the Minister of Education to serve four-year terms.

An individual who applies to become a trustee must be qualified as specified in the *Education Act*, Sections 219 and 228.

Qualifications under the Act include:

- The person is a resident in the area of jurisdiction of the board.

Disqualifications under the Act include:

- The person is an employee of a district school board or authority;
- The person ceases to hold the qualifications;
- The person is convicted of an indictable offense for which he/she has not been pardoned.

Trustees must possess the following core competencies:

- Meet the qualification requirements as stipulated above;
- Have knowledge of, and expertise with, special education; or
- Have professional expertise in the areas of law, healthcare, accounting/finance or public education;
- Have demonstrated an ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing;
- Have interpersonal skills to work effectively as part of a team;
- Have excellent analytical and problem-solving skills;
- Have other skills, as relevant to the needs of the Board; and
- Are committed to JMSA's mission and vision.

*Prior experience serving on a volunteer community board is considered an asset.*
