The Board of Trustees – John McGivney School Authority (JMSA)

The John McGivney School Authority (JMSA) is one of six school authorities located in hospitals or Children's Treatment Centres in Ontario and mandated under Section 68 of the *Education Act*. The JMSA is independent of local district school boards, and as such, has its own trustees, appointed by the Minister of Education.

Trustees are appointed to serve four-year terms.

Under the *Education Act*, in order to be qualified as a trustee on the board, an individual must be a resident of Ontario. An individual who is an employee of a district school board or school authority, or who has been convicted of an indictable offence, is disqualified from applying.
